

## 2010 Erosion Control Permit Fee Schedule

(Effective January 21, 2010)

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### **1. Minor Projects (small area, 50 feet from water, short duration)**

To qualify for this category a project must disturb less than 500 square feet and be located more than 50 feet from a regulated body of water, wetland, or other environmentally sensitive area. 6 month permit.

Deck, patio, or breezeway construction; Fence, garden or landscape installation; Small garage, shed, or barn; Trenching for cable installation; House addition or porch; Garage or shed demolition; Clearing brush, lot leveling; Well installation; Septic repair

\$30.00 + \$35.00 = .....\$65.00

### **2. Moderate Impact Projects (small project close to water or ¼ acre project 50 feet from water)**

Projects in this category will include minor projects that are within 50 feet of a regulated water body, wetland, or sensitive area, as well as those projects 50 to 500 feet from regulated areas that disturb an area of between 500 square feet and 10,000 square feet with slopes less than 6 percent. One year permit.

All above minor projects within 50 feet of water; Garage or pole barn; House addition or porch; Building demolition; Septic system installation; Modular home installation on slab or piers; Lot clearing with no grade change; Landscaping, lot leveling, or fill placement; Seawall repair or installation of seawall less than 50 feet; Retaining wall construction; Rock armoring of shoreline with minimal excavation; Trenching, cable installation, or pipeline repair (<1/4 mile); Roadway improvement, ditching (less than ¼ mile); Beach sanding (<500 sq ft)

\$35.00 + \$60.00 = .....\$95.00

### **3. Major Projects (one acre or less, within 500 feet of water)**

This category involves major excavation for basements, fill placement, or grade changes that affect an area between 10,000 square feet and one acre. Also included are multi-phase projects that involve two or more minor or moderate projects. Major projects may be considered moderate if site characteristics and distance to nearest regulated area make off-site sedimentation virtually impossible.

#### Major project on slope less than 6 percent:

House construction with well and septic; Commercial building; Service facilities, municipal projects; Lot clearing with stump removal and grade changes; Seawall installation 50-150 feet, poured or driven; Small drainage ditch cleanout; Roadway construction up to ¼ mile

\$40.00 + \$90.00 = .....\$130.00  
(Renewal fees: 6 months - \$65.00; one year - \$90.00)

#### Major project on 6 percent or greater slope:

\$60.00 + \$120.00 = .....\$180.00  
(Renewal fees: 6 months - \$75.00; one year - \$100.00)

### **4. Large-scale Projects**

Projects that involve more than one acre of earth disturbance, typically with grade changes over entire site, inclusive of stormwater structures, roadway construction, and utility installation. This category includes shoreline disturbances, other direct disturbance of wetlands and environmentally sensitive areas, and any project requiring DEQ permits.

Projects within 500 feet of regulated water bodies, wetlands, or storm drain inlets:

- Shoreline excavation more than 150'      \$80.00 + \$1.25 per linear foot.....\_\_\_\_\_
- One to 5 acres of disturbance              \$80.00 + \$240.00 = .....\$320.00
- Greater than 5 acres                          \$140.00 + \$120.00 per acre .....\_\_\_\_\_

Projects not within 500 feet of regulated water or storm drain inlets:

- One to 5 acres of disturbance              \$60.00 + \$150.00 = .....\$210.00
- Greater than 5 acres of disturbance      \$100.00 + \$70.00 per acre .....\_\_\_\_\_
